

Wayne Stott
1944-2014



Wayne Glenn Stott was born in Melbourne on 18th June in 1944 and obtained his MBBS from Melbourne University in 1968 and FRACS in 1975.

He did his surgical training as Registrar of Repatriation at the General Hospital in Heidelberg and in Perth in 1971, was a demonstrator in anatomy at Monash University in 1970, and Registrar for General Surgery in Edinburgh in 1973.

Wayne's plastic surgery training was conducted as Registrar for Plastic Surgery at Royal Perth hospital in 1972, Registrar of Plastic surgery in Edinburgh in 1974-5. From October to December 1974 he was a Fellow in Plastic Surgery at the University of Miami, and from January to July 1975 was a Fellow in Hand Surgery at the University of Louisiana in Kentucky.

Back in Australia, Wayne worked at the Western General Hospital, was visiting Specialist at the Repatriation Hospital in Heidelberg and Consultant Plastic Surgeon at Williamstown General Hospital

Other than his work as a surgeon, Wayne was a vigneron at his beloved Wildwood Vineyard, and an active shooter and fly fisher.

He passed away peacefully on 29 May 2014 following a long battle with cancer. Wayne was the devoted husband of Noël and father of Campbell, Matthew, Adam and Alistair. Father-in-law of Jacqueline and Eleanor, and Grandpa to Nathan, Chloe, Edward and Jessica.
