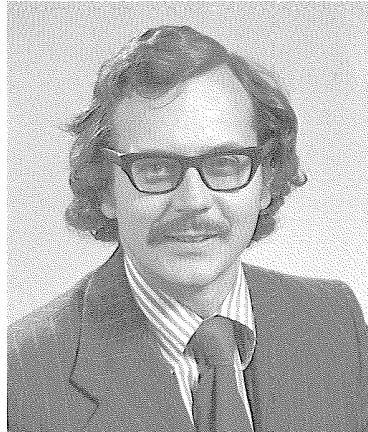


**Neil Alister Turner
(known as Alister)
1939 – 2018**



Alister Turner was born on September 24, 1939 in Guildford, United Kingdom. Son of Henry Alister Turner and Florence Neilena McGilp Anderson. He arrived in Australia in 1941 and obtained his MBBS in Western Australia in 1962, FRCS in England in 1969 and FRACS in 1974.

Alister was a member of the Medical Advisory Board, Bethesda Hospital since 1987, and in 1997 became Chairman. He Co-founded the Lion's Skin Cancer Screening, West Australia in 1989 and was also co-organiser of the Lion's Skin Cancer Research.

He was a member of the Australian Hand Surgery Society, Australasian Society Aesthetic Plastic Surgery (past president), West Australian Society Plastic Surgeons (past president), Australian Society Plastic Surgeons, Royal Australasian College Surgery, British Association Plastic Surgeons and the Western Australian Turf Club.
